



**ST ANDREW'S CHURCH
ARRANGEMENTS FOR MUSIC AT OCCASIONAL SERVICES**
As from October 2008

The *Music Director has the sole right to play at all occasional services of the church. He may permit some other competent person to play at any such services but in that event, he shall be entitled to receive the fee. Where he is unable to play, he may delegate the responsibility to an assistant, who shall receive the fee. Permission for another competent person to play will not be unreasonably withheld.

I. When fees fall due

Fees will be payable directly to the Music Director:

- for weddings, either prior to the first rehearsal, or ten days before the ceremony, whichever is the earlier;
- for funerals and thanksgivings: either prior to the service itself, or, if applicable, prior to the first rehearsal.

II. Fee Schedule

The schedule of fees is as follows:

Playing only (organ and/or piano)	£80
Playing and/or directing other musicians on the day, including pre-service rehearsal	£100
Each additional rehearsal	£25

If any recording is to be made, formal consent is required from the musicians and additional fees will be payable to the Music Director as follows:

Audio recording (amateur or professional): additional 50% fees

Video recording (amateur or professional): additional 100% fees.
