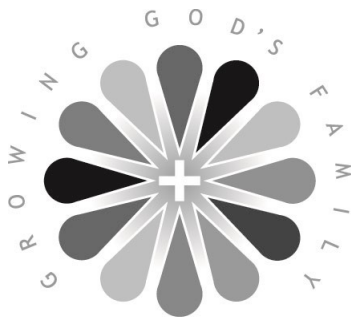


## WELCOME TO ST ANDREW'S
